

Volunteers Needed for UC Sexual Violence Prevention Research Study

If you are an undergraduate student at any of the University of California campuses who has been exposed to some form of unwanted sexual experiences since being enrolled, you may be eligible.

During the interview, you will be asked about:

- Your exposure to unwanted sexual experiences (who was involved, when did it happen, if you told anyone, etc.)
 - How your campus helped or could have helped you
 - Advice to give others going through similar experiences
 - Anything else you think is helpful in preventing this violence at the UC
- *Your participation is voluntary and you are free to leave whenever*

WHAT ARE UNWANTED SEXUAL EXPERIENCES?

We define unwanted sexual attention as any of the following:

1. Sexual harassment
2. Stalking
3. Intimate partner violence/dating violence
4. Sexual assault

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 18 years or older
- Having a way of being contacted (e.g. phone or email)
- Provide consent online to be involved in the study
- Been exposed to unwanted sexual experiences while enrolled at your UC
- Available and able to participate in a 60-90 minute interview via Zoom

PARTICIPANTS WILL RECEIVE

- Campus and community support and referrals offered
- All information shared will be kept as confidential as possible
- Interviews conducted online, in private by trauma-informed researchers
- Receive a \$50 gift card for your time
